WHEREAS, the Montpelier Senior Activity Center, established in 1967, is a division of the city of Montpelier with the mission of enhancing the quality of life for the older adults in the Montpelier area through opportunities that develop physical, mental, cultural, social, and economic well-being in a welcoming, flexible environment; and

WHEREAS, the Montpelier Senior Activity Center serves more than 1,000 seniors every year, including more than one of every senior in Montpelier; and

WHEREAS, the Montpelier Senior Activity Center provides opportunities for healthy aging and lifelong learning that enhance the quality of life for seniors in central Vermont; and

WHEREAS, the Montpelier Senior Activity Center offers dozens of weekly programs to promote healthy minds and healthy bodies, ranging from foreign language classes to yoga; and

WHEREAS, in 2016, the Montpelier Senior Activity Center provided more than 17,000 nutritious, home-delivered and community meals for seniors; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, June 10, 2017, the Montpelier Senior Activity Center will celebrate 50 years of service to the community at a Gala Celebration at the Capitol Plaza Hotel in Montpelier.

MONTPELIER SENIOR ACTIVITY CENTER DAY


