2013; and

WHEREAS, Lyme disease, anaplasmosis and other tickborne diseases can be

prevented by engaging in healthy behaviors such as using appropriate repellants, conducting frequent tick checks, and safely

removing ticks; and

WHEREAS, when diagnosed in their early stages, most cases of tickborne

diseases can be treated effectively.
