special needs and priorities of their communities and provide services in a linguistically and culturally relevant manner; and

WHEREAS, Vermont's community health centers are staffed by health

professionals who have chosen to serve communities in need, helping to expand the reach of primary care and preventative health

services; and

**WHEREAS,** Vermont's community health centers help to contain overall health

care costs through integrated preventative and primary care health

services, treating the whole person.
