WHEREAS, VTE affects between 600,000 to 1 million Americans each year; and

WHEREAS, nearly a quarter of pulmonary embolus patients present with death

before they are diagnosed, and many in the general public are not

aware of the disease; and

WHEREAS, citizens are encouraged to learn signs and symptoms of VTE, their

family's medical history, and how to prevent this common disease.
