- WHEREAS,** case management is a primary medical management strategy that fosters the careful shepherding of healthcare dollars while maintaining a primary and consistent focus on patient advocacy; and
- WHEREAS,** case management services enhance quality of life while promoting the achievement of positive healthcare outcomes; and
- WHEREAS,** case management is an integral component of healthcare delivery in Vermont and throughout the United States.
