feral or stray, are unaltered; and

**WHEREAS,** spaying and neutering has been shown to dramatically reduce

the number of animals who are put down in animal shelters;

and

**WHEREAS,** programs exist to assist with the cost of spaying or neutering

pets living in poverty and community cats; and

WHEREAS, veterinarians, national and local animal protection

organizations, and private citizens work together to advocate

the spaying and neutering of pets and community cats.
