NMO symptoms; and

WHEREAS, increased awareness of the disease has allowed doctors to

become more likely to recognize the varying manifestations of

the disease; and

**WHEREAS,** the NMO community is dedicated to increasing awareness and

understanding about this disease in order to promote research, improved patient care and outcomes so that a cure may

ultimately be found.
