WHEREAS, 100 years ago, 94 Vermont farmers came together around Cabot,

Vermont to turn their excess milk and resources into butter through a new co-operative model, and while enduring times of both success and challenge, 100 years later, the Cabot Creamery and its farm families remain true to their co-operative mission and continue to thrive; and

WHEREAS, by pooling their resources, the farmers of 1919 shipped their milk and

butter products to Boston and New York – markets which were hard to

reach during that era; and

WHEREAS, in 1989, Cabot took first place in the cheddar category at the U.S.

Championship Cheese Contest, kicking off years of awards at national

and international competitions; and

WHEREAS, Cabot Creamery Cooperative has been in continuous operation in

Vermont since 1919, makes a full line of cheeses, Greek yogurt, sour cream, cottage cheese and butter which are distributed to all 50 states and 22 countries, is widely known as the makers of "The World's Best Cheddar", and remains owned by the 1,000 dairy farm families of Agri-

Mark, the Northeast's premier dairy cooperative; and

WHEREAS, more than 800 Cabot farmers live and work in Vermont, more than 600

Vermonters are employed by Cabot, and since its founding, all profits have been returned to the farm families who own the co-operative – a

practice that continues to this day; and

WHEREAS, Cabot collaborates with thousands of non-profits by honoring

volunteers committed to strengthening their communities – a reflection

of Cabot farmers' values; and

WHEREAS, in this Centennial Year, the farm families of Cabot are honoring with

pride the cooperation and foresight of their founding farms a century ago and remain focused on ensuring the next generations of family farms are able to continue farming and contributing to the quality of

life in Vermont.
