**WHEREAS,** physical activity reduces risk, at all ages, of obesity and chronic

disease; and

WHEREAS, participation in sports and all kinds of active pastimes can help

improve physical and mental wellbeing; and

**WHEREAS,** the Vermont Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Sports,

Department of Health, other state agencies, and private and nonprofit organizations establish opportunities for physical activity in worksites, schools, and communities throughout the state and provide opportunities for all people to enjoy physical activity on a

regular basis; and

**WHEREAS,** the month of May is traditionally recognized as National Physical

Fitness and Sports Month to encourage the broad promotion of and

participation in physical fitness activities.
