WHEREAS, Central Service Technicians play a most important role in patient care arenas, and are responsible for first-line processes to prevent patient infections; and


WHEREAS, Sterile Processing Week recognizes the contribution Central Service Technicians make to patient safety and the opportunities and challenges facing the profession.

STERILE PROCESSING WEEK


