WHEREAS, Shallow Water Blackout is caused by prolonged breath holding preceded

> by hyperventilating (also known as Hypoxic Training), which prevents the brain from receiving the signal that it is time to take a breath, resulting in the brain blacking out and then the body taking a natural breath underwater

causing the swimmer to drown; and

WHEREAS, ending Shallow Water Blackout drowning through educating swimmers of

> all ages about the life-threatening dangers associated with Hypoxic Training, or prolonged breath holding practice, is one of the primary

causes of the Live Like Benjo Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the Live Like Benjo Foundation is a Vermont based 501(c)(3) non-profit

> organization dedicated to the memory of Benjamin C. Haller, who loved Vermont and was a Smugglers' Notch and Mount Mansfield High School Team State Champion Alpine Skier, Vermont sailor, SCUBA and Sailing Instructor, and Rescue Diver who drowned in seven feet of water on

August 1, 2014, as a result of Shallow Water Blackout; and

one of the Live Like Benjo Foundation's missions is to save lives and WHEREAS,

prevent families from having to experience the pain of such needless and avoidable tragedies as those caused by Shallow Water Blackout; and

WHEREAS, the Live Like Benjo Foundation is committed to working with Vermont

State Agencies, schools, all swimming facilities, lifeguards, casual swimmers, and anybody involved with water-related sports to raise awareness about the causes of Shallow Water Blackouts, their associated

and deadly dangers, and how they can be prevented; and

WHEREAS, August is the ideal month for this designation as the summer swimming

season is at its peak throughout our great state.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim August 2021 as

SHALLOW WATER BLACKOUT AWARENESS MONTH

in Vermont.
