WHEREAS, across Vermont, clean and readily abundant forms of energy are powering

more homes and businesses than ever before; and

WHEREAS, Vermont is committed to renewable energy that benefits our economy and

environment; and

WHEREAS, Vermont's growing energy economy has created jobs while reducing

consumer demand for high-cost, high-carbon "peak energy" by creating and supporting clean, renewable energy sources and increasing energy

efficiency and load flexibility; and

WHEREAS, clean energy is part of America's energy future and includes generation

from multiple renewable resources; and

WHEREAS, the clean energy sector is a growing part of the economy and has been a

key driver of economic growth in Vermont in recent years, given that Vermont has the highest clean energy employment per capita in the nation

at 6.2%; and

WHEREAS, most of these jobs cannot be outsourced due to the on-site nature of

construction, installation, and maintenance, and are inherently local, and

contribute to the growth of local economies.
