A Proclamation**

WHEREAS, SASH (Support and Services at Home) was created in 2011 to provide a system for coordinating health care and support services for older Vermonters and those with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, SASH works to provide older Vermonters and those with disabilities the autonomy and structure of support needed to remain at home throughout their lives; and

WHEREAS, SASH relies on regional partnerships with the area agencies on aging, home health agencies, community mental health agencies, community health teams, primary care practices, hospitals and others to provide a comprehensive system for the delivery of individualized and population-based support and programs at home; and

WHEREAS, partnerships and funding from the Department of Disabilities, Aging and Independent Living, OneCare Vermont, the Green Mountain Care Board and the Vermont Department of Health have been essential to SASH's success and expansion, having currently served over 10,600 participants throughout Vermont; and

WHEREAS, this year SASH celebrates its 10th anniversary, commemorating its ongoing legacy of serving vulnerable Vermonters with compassion and care.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim November 12, 2021 as

SUPPORT AND SERVICES AT HOME (SASH) DAY


