**WHEREAS,** the University of Vermont Rescue ("UVM Rescue") is a non-profit,

volunteer, primarily undergraduate, Advanced Life Support (ALS) ambulance organization that was founded in 1971 by several

enterprising first year students; and

**WHEREAS,** in the summer of 1972, UVM Rescue purchased and drove the first

of its kind modular Omaha-orange ambulance up from

Massachusetts to Burlington; and

WHEREAS, UVM Rescue was the first ambulance in the state of Vermont to run

with a licensed EMT on every crew, the first ambulance in Vermont to not also serve as a hearse, and, the first ambulance service to run

with the entire crew being an EMT; and

WHEREAS, UVM Rescue was the first volunteer ambulance crew in Vermont to

staff in-station 24/7, 365 days a year; and

**WHEREAS,** since UVM Rescue's inception has continued to grow responding to

over 1400 calls both at UVM and within the greater Burlington area

annually; and

WHEREAS, UVM Rescue supports programs including UVM Men's and

Women's Basketball games, UVM Hockey games, Spring and Fall Fest, Rail Jam, Commencement, Convocation, Burlington City Marathon, Lake Monster Baseball games, and many more; and

WHEREAS. UVM Rescue is one of seventeen collegiate EMS organizations with

transport capabilities but the only one that is completely student-run

in the country.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim April 25, 2022 as

## **UVM RESCUE DAY**

in Vermont.
