A Proclamation**

WHEREAS, lakes and ponds provide drinking water, transportation, recreational and tourism opportunities, and scenic beauty for the residents and visitors of Vermont; and

WHEREAS, these beneficial uses are of fundamental importance to Vermont's history, culture, and economic vitality; and

WHEREAS, our lakes and ponds improve the quality of life for all Vermont residents, and their importance should not go unnoticed; and

WHEREAS, Vermont recognizes the need to protect the ecological integrity and natural resiliency of these lakes and ponds for future generations particularly as climate change creates new challenges.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim July 2022 as


