WHEREAS, Team Rubicon has utilized the skills and experiences of military veterans and first responders through its volunteer program; and


WHEREAS, by focusing on underserved or economically challenged communities, Team Rubicon seeks to make the largest impact possible by serving those who are underserved.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim August 8, 2022 as


