A Proclamation**

WHEREAS, Vermont is dedicated to being a leader in the use of clean energy and recognizes vehicle transportation electrification as an essential strategy for meeting the State's climate and energy goals outlined in Vermont's Comprehensive Energy Plan and Climate Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the State has recently expanded funding for vehicle electrification purchase incentives for Vermont residents, through federal grant awards towards electrifying Vermont's public transit fleet, and through investments in multifamily residential, workplace, destination, and highway corridor charging; and

WHEREAS, the transportation sector must continue adopting clean energy technology, including plug-in electric vehicles, which contributes to greater energy-security and supports a healthy environment and economy; and

WHEREAS, meeting Vermont's climate and energy goals will help make the state attractive to residents, employers, workers, and tourists.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim September 26 - 30, 2022 as
