## State of Vermont Executive Department A Proclamation

WHEREAS, the beginning of fall marks an important time for employers in the tourism and hospitality

industry, with a greater emphasis on seasonal workers to meet the demands of visitors to

the Vermont; and

**WHEREAS,** the hospitality and tourism industry is made up of local inns, restaurants, mountain resorts

and attractions which are all within Vermont's historic downtowns, villages, and small

cities; and

**WHEREAS,** Vermont is a global tourist destination that sees 13.3 million visitors annually who generate

\$3 billion on lodging, food, drink, and goods and services, propelling tourism to one of

Vermont's top industries: and

**WHEREAS**, an average of nearly 30,000 Vermonters are employed in the industry, making up about

10% of Vermont's workforce; and

WHEREAS, Vermonters working in the tourism industry earn more than six percent of the state's total

income, totaling more than \$1 billion; and

**WHEREAS,** opportunities for tourism professionals widely range from marketing directors to customer

relations specialists, from ski lift operators to banquet managers; and

WHEREAS, jobs in the industry provide workers with great career opportunities and benefits, including

full-time and part-time positions, perks and incentives, and other flexibilities; and

**WHEREAS,** the Agency of Commerce and Community Development, and specifically the Department

of Tourism and Marketing promote Vermont's travel, recreation, cultural and historic attractions, as well as the Vermont's goods and services, in coordination with public and private sector partners and to market to a global audience in a manner consistent with the

values and traditions of the state for the economic benefit of all Vermonters; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor seeks to improve the lives of working Vermonters by making

connections between employers and jobseekers.
