WHEREAS, Delta Flight 723 made a quick stop in Manchester, New Hampshire to pick up more passengers when the original flight was cancelled; and

WHEREAS, the weather was unusually foggy and the misguided Delta Flight 723 crashed into the seawall, resulting in the loss of 89 lives; and


WHEREAS, after 50 years thoughts of that day still linger in the minds of family members, friends, colleagues and many who remember that day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim July 31, 2023, as


**DELTA FLIGHT 723 DAY OF REMEMBRANCE
