WHEREAS, despite their rarity, mast cell diseases deserve attention and support to improve the quality of life for those affected and their families; and


WHEREAS, research and advancements in medical science are critical to enhancing our understanding of mast cell diseases and developing effective treatment and therapies; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim October 20, 2023, as
