health and mental health services; and

WHEREAS, for over 50 years, Community Health Centers have been on the front

lines in emergencies and disasters, caring for all patients, regardless of insurance status or ability to pay, with a sliding fee scale; and

WHEREAS, Vermont's 11 community health centers operate across all 14

counties in Vermont and provide care to almost a third of

Vermonters; and

WHEREAS, Vermont's Community Health Centers offer service regardless of

insurance coverage or ability to pay; and

WHEREAS, Vermont's Community Health Centers provide services that address

environmental and social factors, including transportation, food access, mental health, and substance use disorder, as an integral part of primary care, tailoring those services to fit the special needs and

priorities of their communities; and

WHEREAS, Vermont's Community Health Centers help contain overall health

care costs through integrated preventive and primary care health

services, treating the whole person.
