WHEREAS, WVRA has continually exemplified the best of Vermont’s spirit of service and commitment to one’s neighbor; and


WHEREAS, Vermont recognizes and honors White River Valley Ambulance for its 50 years of invaluable contributions to the health and safety of its community.
