WHEREAS, the Latin tongue is of use to all, both in speaking and in writing the English language with style and effect; and

WHEREAS, also all things that to this study do pertain both in upper schools and at the University of Vermont ought to be carried on; and

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of April, many of the school pupils in Vermont who concern themselves with matters of Latin will come to an assembly at the University of Vermont in the 41st year of the annual festival.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, do hereby proclaim the week of April 2-8, 2017 as
