**WHEREAS,** increased awareness of Neurofibromatosis will help initiate critical research; and


**WHEREAS,** Neurofibromatosis patients and families of Vermont are determined to spread awareness of this serious condition in communities across the state.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim May 2019 as


**NEUROFIBROMATOSIS AWARENESS MONTH**
