estimated 38 percent of the U.S. population is eligible to donate

blood, less than 10 percent actually do; and

WHEREAS, Vermont Blood Donation Day effectively serves to remind us that

we need to constantly replenish our blood supply through donation

and community awareness.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim September 5, 2019 as

BLOOD DONATION DAY

in Vermont and call this observance to the attention of all Vermonters.
