**WHEREAS,** pharmacists have been providing Vermonters medicine and counsel since the 18<sup>th</sup> century; and

**WHEREAS,** Vermont was one of the safest states to live in during the COVID pandemic; and

**WHEREAS,** appropriate measures to provide for the health, safety, and protection of Vermonters, including vaccinations, have been implemented at the highest state levels of state government; and

**WHEREAS,** pharmacists, student pharmacists, and pharmacy technicians constitute an essential component of the healthcare delivery system in Vermont; and


**WHEREAS,** Vermonters need ready access to prescription medications, vaccinations, point of care testing, and clinical pharmacist care; and
