and contributes \$194 million to the state's economy annually; and

WHEREAS, loggers provide renewable material for products used by people in Vermont every

day; and

**WHEREAS**, loggers are the root of Vermont's \$2.1 billion forest economy; and

WHEREAS, loggers are the means by which healthy and responsible forest management plans

are accomplished; and

WHEREAS, logging supports healthy forests that maintain vital animal habitats, protect

watersheds, sequester carbon, provide recreational opportunities, and reduce the risk

of loss of life and property from wildfires; and

WHEREAS, logging provides health for our forests through regeneration to ensure the

sustainability of the industry for future generations of Vermonters.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2024 as
