A Proclamation

WHEREAS, caring and committed mentors offer support for youth by providing a consistent friend, helping to ignite a young person’s curiosity, solidify their passions, and leverage their talents; and

WHEREAS, youth with mentors exhibit improved resiliency, better relationships with peers and family members, and feel more connected to their community and school; and

WHEREAS, youth with mentors are more likely to volunteer in their communities, participate in sports and extracurricular activities, and hold a leadership position in a sports team, club, student council or other organization; and

WHEREAS, youth with mentors are more likely to graduate from high school and pursue post-secondary education; and

WHEREAS, local mentoring programs provide a connection between older and younger generations, and strengthen ties among all members of the community while also providing individualized attention and support, a primary component of pandemic recovery; and


